






Tutorial: Basic Netting

Needed Materials:

Toho 11o beads 2 colors (A and B)

Fireline thread 6lb

Needle #12

	<p>Step 1:</p> <p>Pick up 2 A, 1 B, 2 A, 1 B, 2 A, 1 B, 2A, 1 B, 2 A, 1 B, 2 A, 1 B, 2 A, and 1 B, for a total of 21 beads.</p>
	<p>Step 2:</p> <p>Pick up 2 A, 1 B, 3 A, and 1 B. Pass through the first B bead.</p>
	<p>This is what it should look like.</p>



Step 3:




Pick up 2 A, 1 B, and 2 A. Skipping the next B bead, pass through the B bead that's next.



This is what it should look like.



Repeat step 3 to continue your netting.

	<p>...</p>
	<p>Finish this row by passing through the B bead at the end.</p>
	<p>This is what it should look like.</p>






To add an additional row, we must turn around. Repeat step 2.



This is what it should look like.



Repeat step 2 to complete your row.
