




Tutorial: Flat Herringbone




Needed Materials:

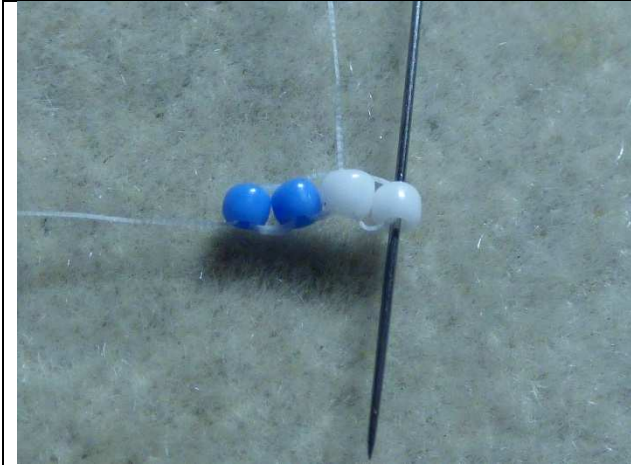
Toho beads – 110

Fireline thread 6lb

Needle #12

	<p>Step 1:</p> <p>Pick up 2 beads.</p>
	<p>Pass back up the first bead that was added.</p>
	<p>Pass back down the second bead added.</p>

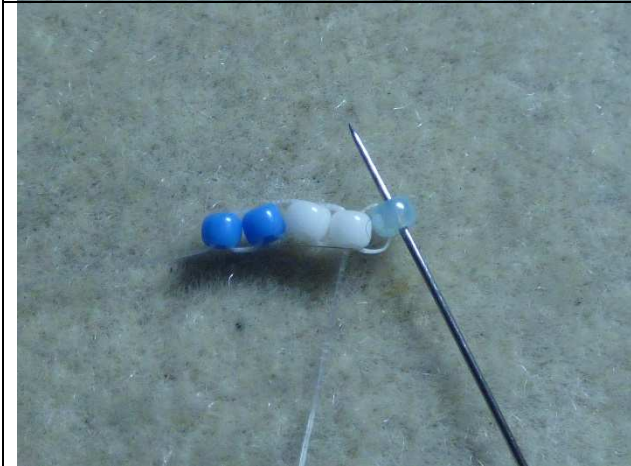
	<p>Step 2:</p> <p>Pick up 1 bead and pass down through the bead last added.</p>
	<p>Pass back up the newly added bead.</p>
	<p>Repeat step 2 until you have a total of 6 beads.</p>



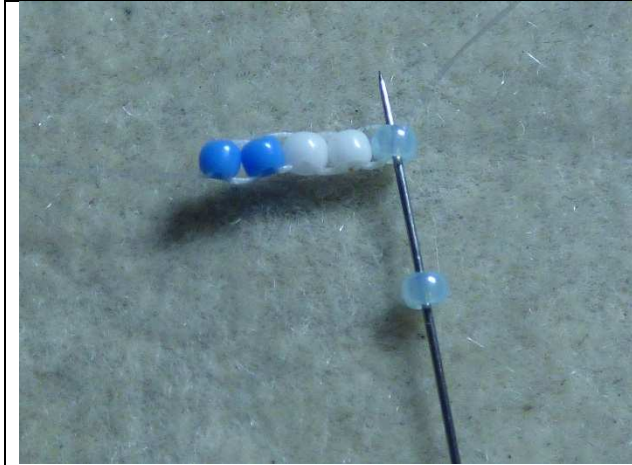
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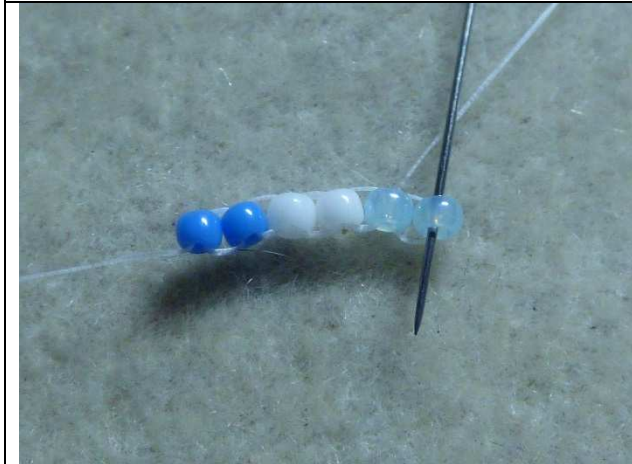
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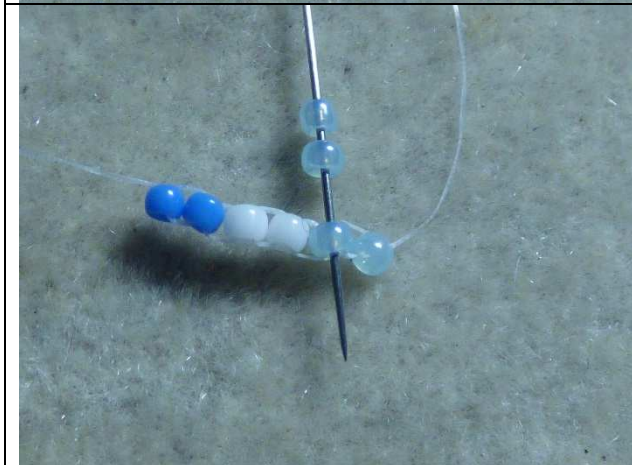
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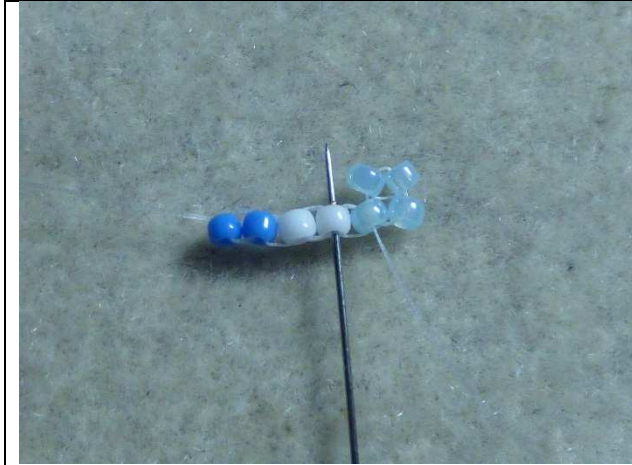


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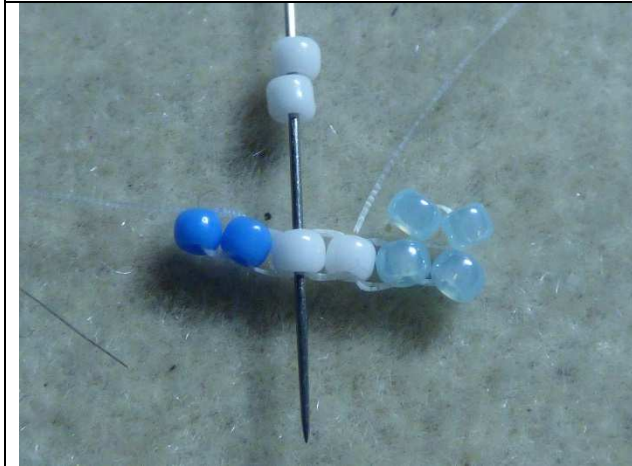


Step 3:

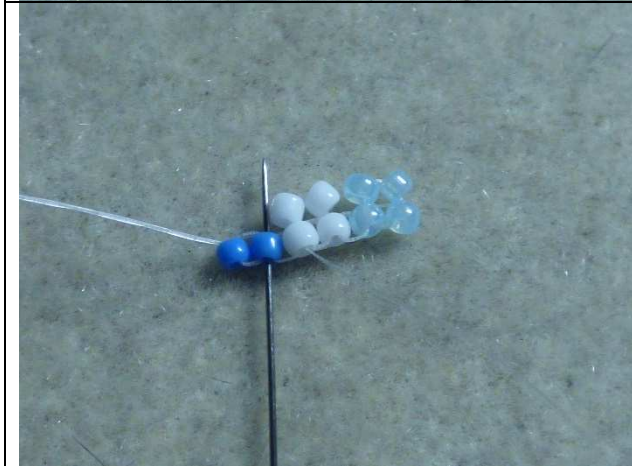
Now pick up 2 beads and pass down the bead next to last.



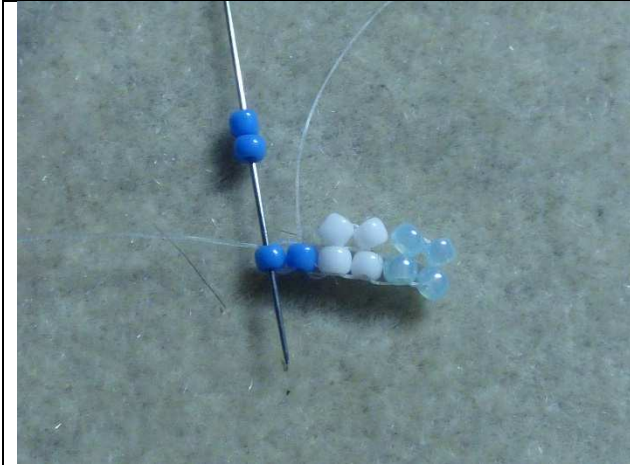
Pass up the next bead.



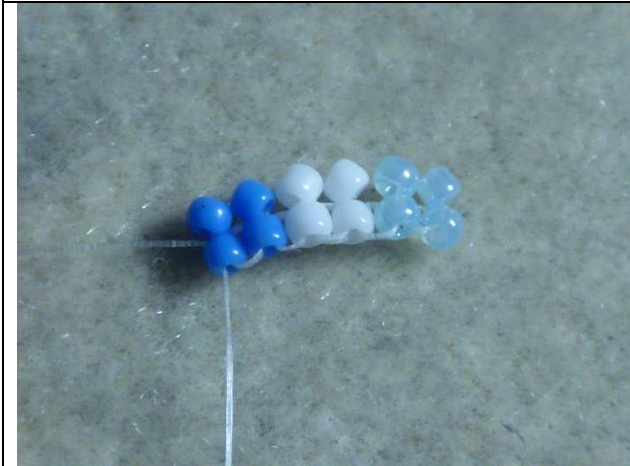
Repeat step 3 for the remainder of your row.



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This is what it should look like.
Repeat step 3 until you are satisfied
with the length of your design.
