



## Tutorial: Flat Herringbone

### Needed Materials:




Delica Beads

Toho beads – 150

14mm Rivoli

Fireline thread 6lb

Needle #12

	<p>Step 1:</p> <p>Pick up 36 delica beads. Pass back through all the beads once more, to create a circle. Pick up 1 bead and, skipping a bead, pass through the next delica.</p>
	<p>This is what it should look like.</p>
	<p>Continue in this manner all the way around your circle.</p>



To step up to begin a new row, when adding your last bead, pass through both the next bead and the first bead added in this row.



This is what it should look like.



Step 2:

Now it's time to tighten our circle using smaller beads. Pick up 1 150 and, skipping a bead, pass through the next bead that is sticking out.



This is what it should look like.



Repeat step 2 all the way around your circle.



Remember, to step up, pass through both the next bead and the first bead added in this row.





This is what it should look like.






Tighten your circle.



Repeat step 2 all the way around your circle to add a second row of 15os.

	<p>...</p>
	<p>...</p>
	<p>Don't forget to step up at the end of a row!</p>

	<p>This is what it should look like.</p>
	<p>Pass through the beads shown to get into position to add your rivoli.</p>
	<p>Place your rivoli in the bezel cup shiny side down.</p>



Repeat step 2 twice to secure the rivoli in the bezel.



And you are finished!
